Type

A hybrid Crimson Sweet type watermelon.

Maturity

Main season ± 80 days.

Plant Characteristics

A vigorous plant with high, uniform yield.

Plant Population: 4,000 to 8,000 plants per ha.

Adaption: AUDRY is recommended for early season production.

Variety Characteristics

Fruit Characteristics: Large, uniform oval-round fruit with weight of 10 - 13kg. The rind has a medium green colour with light green stripes. The flesh has a bright red colour, with good flavour and brix.

Pollination: Approximately 7 male flowers develop for every female flower. When flowers appear, 2 to 4 bee hives should be placed per ha.

AUDRY is very early maturing and high yielding.
