Medium size tropical pumpkin with a vining growth habit.

Maturity:

Approximately 140 days.

Plant Characteristics:

The variety is vigorous and has a vining growing habit.

Fruit Characteristics:

The seed cavity is small in size, and the fruits have thick flesh. The blossom end scar is very small. The flesh texture and colour are outstanding. The external colour is mottled green. Slight ribbing can be found on the fruits. A wax layer is present on the fruit and uniformity is high. An average weight of 3kg.

Yield Potential:

Above average yield.

Disease Resistance:

Good general disease resistance.

Features & Benefits:

The attractive mottled green fruits have excellent internal quality with a small seed cavity. The uniformity and productivity of CHEETAH make this a very promising hybrid.
