COMMANDANT is a Crisphead type lettuce suited for fresh and pre-pack markets.

Maturity:

55 - 60 days from transplant.

Plant Characteristics:

Large frame with deep green colour. A plant population of between 40,000 - 60,000 plants per hectare is recommended.

Resistance to Fusarium race 1 with excellent heat and tip burn tolerance.
