Plant Characteristics:

Semi-bush growth habit. Can be planted up to 7000 plants per hectare. Quick maturing. Deep orange, thick and very firm flesh, with excellent keeping quality.

Fruit Characteristics:

Medium-sized white fruit with slight ribbing. Fruit has a deep shape with an average weight of 4.5kg. Small seed cavity, thick shoulder and

High.

Good general disease resistance. Early maturity may avoid some disease problems.
